STUDENTS ENTERING FIRST GRADE

LALILO READING and FRECKLE MATH

St. Michael's Academy is continuing with its digital summer activities. During the 2023-2024 school year we transitioned to using Lalilo and Freckle for adaptive learning. These adaptive programs target skills identified through the STARS testing your child participated in throughout the school year. Use of these programs over the summer provide an opportunity for students to strengthen individual skills, master previously taught information and explore new concepts. All current students are registered in Renaissance and have access to both Lalilo and Freckle.

Ms. Dougal's Lalilio-Freckle Summer Challenge requires all current students to complete their assigned amount of adaptive minutes beginning on Monday June 17 and continuing through Friday, August 23 to earn a free dress down day during the first week of school.

***Please remember to complete the provided activity log and return it to school on the first day.

LALILO/FRECKLE REQUIREMENTS

First grade teachers require students to spend a total of 240 minutes split between Lalilo Reading and Freckle Math activities over the summer. This averages out to about 30 minutes per week. Appropriate activities are available upon student login.

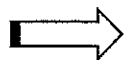

- 50 books read - ? teacher's surprise ?

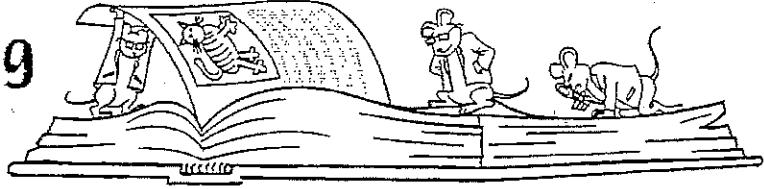
SUMMER MATH REVIEW

- Continue rote counting to 100. Count by 10's and 5's
- Review recognizing numbers 1-30
- Review number order. Ask what comes before or after a particular number. Ask what number comes between two other numbers
- Practice writing numbers to reduce the occurrence of reversals
- Review patterns, sorting and classifying
- Practice matching sets and numerals
- Review the basic concepts of addition and subtraction. Practice both horizontal and vertical problems with sums to 10
- Practice both horizontal and vertical subtraction problems that show subtraction from numbers to 10
