This adaptive program targets skills identified through the STARS testing your child participated in throughout the school year. Use of this program over the summer provides an opportunity for students to strengthen individual skills, master previously taught information and explore new concepts. All current students are registered in Renaissance and have access to Freckle.

Ms. Dougal's Freckle Summer Challenge requires all current students to complete their assigned amount of adaptive minutes beginning on Monday, June 17 and continuing through Friday, August 23 to earn a free dress down day during the first week of school.

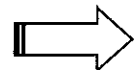
***Please remember to complete the provided activity log and return it to school on the first day.

FRECKLE REQUIREMENTS

- Adding/subtracting into hundreds with regrouping.

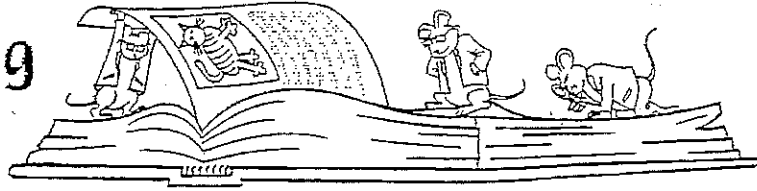
