All current students are registered in Renaissance and have access to Freckle.

Ms. Dougal's Freckle Summer Challenge requires all current students to complete their assigned amount of adaptive minutes beginning on Monday, June 17 and continuing through Friday, August 23 to earn a free dress down day during the first week of school.

***Please remember to complete the provided activity log and return it to school on the first day.

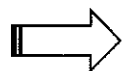
FRECKLE REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADE 5

Fifth grade teachers require students to spend a total of 360 minutes split between Freckle English and Math activities over the summer. This averages out to about 45 minutes per week. Appropriate activities are available upon student login.

Science and Social Studies activities are optional but DO NOT count towards the dress down challenge.

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SUMMER MATH REVIEW

- Addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division facts 0-12 **Mastered**
 - Addition of whole numbers with both addends into the thousands using regrouping.
 - Subtraction of whole numbers into thousands using regrouping, including regrouping with zeros
 - Read/write and recognize numbers up to the hundred thousands place: identify place value, value, write standard form and word form.
Ex: 423,625 (standard form)
Four hundred twenty-three thousand, six hundred twenty-five (word form)
Place of underlined digit-ten thousands
Value of underlined digit 20,000
 - Rounding to the nearest ten, hundred, thousand, ten thousand, hundred thousand
 - Long division – one digit divisors $276 \div 2$
 - Multiplication – two digit x two digit / three digit
