St. Michael's Academy is continuing with its digital summer activities. During the 2023-2024 school year we transitioned to using Freckle for adaptive learning. This adaptive program targets skills identified through the STARS testing your child participated in throughout the school year. Use of this program over the summer provides an opportunity for students to strengthen individual skills, master previously taught information and explore new concepts. All current students are registered in Renaissance and have access to Freckle.

Ms. Dougal's Freckle Summer Challenge requires all current students to complete their assigned amount of adaptive minutes beginning on Monday, June 17 and continuing through Friday, August 23 to earn a free dress down day during the first week of school.

FRECKLE REQUIREMENTS FOR SEVENTH GRADE

Seventh grade teachers require students to spend a total of 480 minutes split between Freckle English (240 minutes) and Math activities (240 minutes) over the summer. This averages out to about 60 minutes per week. Appropriate activities are available upon student login.

Science and Social Studies activities are optional but DO NOT count towards the dress down challenge.
